## PARKING

Parking (for people not already holding a Cornell parking permit) will be in the parking lot located south of Morrison Hall, about ½ mile from Kennedy Hall. Parking permits are \$6 in advance. Buses run by the parking lot and west on Tower Road at 15-minute intervals (fee \$1.50, exact change please). **Deadline for receipt of requests for parking permits is November 25.** If you don't pre-register but plan to attend the conference, you will have to pay \$10 for a visitor's pass at one of the parking booths. You also have the option of purchasing a 4-hour visitor pass for \$6.00 if you do not intend to stay for the entire conference. (Note: There is very limited visitor parking near Kennedy Hall.)
